Privacy Regulation Ibn Battuta

Personal data that can be used

Ibn Battuta can use your personal data, because you make use of the service of Ibn Battuta and because you filled them in when signing up for Ibn Battuta. Ibn Battuta can make use of the following personal data:

- ❖ Your first and last name
- ❖ Your address data
- ❖ Your phone number
- ❖ Your email address
- ❖ Pictures taken during activities
- ❖ Your IBAN

Why Ibn Battuta needs your personal data

Ibn Battuta uses your personal data for several reasons. Your first and last name are used to show when you signed up for an activity (only visible for members) and for our administration. Your phone number is to get in touch with you when you ask for this and to reach you when necessary. Your address data are used when we unexpectedly cannot reach you by phone, or to send cards for e.g. Christmas.

By signing up for Ibn Battuta you agree that pictures taken during activities on which you are visible can also be uploaded on the website of Ibn Battuta. These pictures are only visible for members of Ibn Battuta. The pictures are selected carefully and all other pictures that are not on the website will be deleted. If you do not agree with a picture of you on the website then you can reach out to the board through phone, email or personal contact and make sure it will be deleted. Lastly, your IBAN is used for the automatic collections to make sure all payments for activities can be handled as fluently as possible. This will **never** happen without your consent, e.g. signing up for an activity.

How long does Ibn Battuta save your personal data

Ibn Battuta will never save your personal data for longer than strictly necessary to realize the goals, for which your data are collected. Your data will not be saved for longer than a year when there is no agreement with you concerning this.

Sharing with others

Ibn Battuta will only share your personal data with third parties when this is necessary for carrying out an agreement with you, or to comply with a legal obligation.

Mapping your website use

On the website of Ibn Battuta general webvisit data will be kept track of, such as the IP-address of your computer and the time of extraction and data that your browsers sends. These data will be used for analysis of visit- and clicking behavior on the website. Ibn Battuta uses this information to better the operation of the website. These data will be anonymized as much as possible and will never be shared with third parties.

View, change or delete personal data

You always have the right to view, correct or delete your personal data. You can edit your date of birth, given name, profile picture, email address, mobile & home phone number and your address on your own. If you want to edit your First or Last name(s), your gender, a photo of you posted on the website or your bank account details, then you can file a request of correction or deletion to the board of Ibn Battuta through board@ibnbattuta.nl, call the board at +31 50 363 39 09 or reach out to one of the board members personally.



Safety of your data

Ibn Battuta takes the protection of your data seriously and takes fitting measures to prevent misuse, loss, unauthorized access, unwanted disclosure and unauthorized modification of your personal data.
